### WORK PACKAGE 4: LIVED EXPERIENCE UPDATE

Work Package 4 (public benchmarking pilot in prostate cancer) continues to advance with workshops held with people with lived experience (PWLE) of prostate cancer on 26 and 27 November. The workshops were well attended with 13 people joining and providing their views on what unmet need the product should address.

These workshops, and the continued partnership with PWLE at every step of the process, emphasises our commitment to ensuring their voices are heard and shape Pan Cancer Initiative final products.

The team is now collating the information provided during the workshops and will be meeting with the Advisory Group in late January to discuss and further refine the product before moving to the next phase of the Work Package.



### WORK PACKAGE 1: PUBLICATION OF OUR ENGAGEMENT REPORTS

We are pleased to share that two key reports have now been published.

#### Just Ask: How Are You Feeling?

Our Lived Experience Engagement Report, capturing the voices of 97 people affected by cancer and their perspectives on what matters most in their care.

#### Patient Reported Measures: Cancer Sector Engagement

Our Sector Engagement Report, reflecting insights of 121 clinicians, researchers, registries, and policy makers from across Australia.

Together, these reports provide valuable insights into the outcome and experience domains considered most important by stakeholders, as well as the barriers and enablers to collecting patient-reported measures.

These findings have directly informed the recommended Core Outcome Set of PROMs and PREMs developed for Work Package 1.
