CQR FACE-TO-FACE WORKSHOP

On 26 February, Movember and Cancer Australia hosted a joint workshop with the Pan Cancer Consortium Clinical Quality Registries (CQRs) at Monash University in Melbourne.

The morning session, led by Cancer Australia, focused on the National Data Framework.

In the afternoon session, the Pan Cancer team from Movember alongside Cancer Australia provided an update on the Pan Cancer Initiative.

The session began with an overview of the Initiative, its seven work packages, and the opportunities for CQRs to remain actively involved in the program. Later discussions focused on the implementation of the Core Outcome Set, the CQR Grant Funding Opportunity, and opportunities to utilise the ePRMs collection platform developed through Work Package 2.

The first stream focuses on assessing the feasibility of national-level automated data capture across Clinical Quality Registries (CQRs) and developing a business case for future investment.

The second stream focuses on smaller-scale grant funding opportunities for participating CQRs. These grants will support registries to implement targeted data automation initiatives within their own systems, helping to reduce manual data collection burden while improving data quality and sustainability across the network.

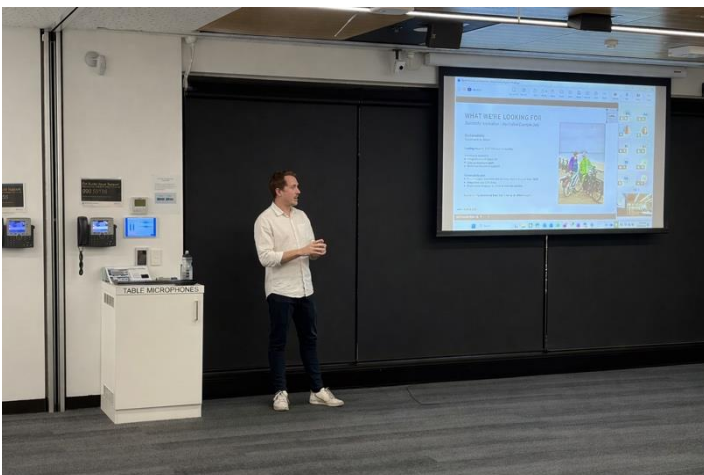


WORK PACKAGE 6 REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL OUTCOME

We are pleased to announce that Nous Group has been selected as the successful vendor for the Work Package 6 Request for Proposal. Nous Group will undertake a comprehensive feasibility assessment and develop a business case to inform investment in Clinical Quality Registry (CQR) data automation.

Nous Group has extensive experience in the area, having delivered projects for organisations including the Department of Health, CSIRO, and Cancer Australia.

The team will now commence the Discovery Phase of the project, with the feasibility assessment being the first component of this work.

WORK PACKAGE 6 CQR GRANT FUNDING OPPORTUNITY

We recently launched a closed grant funding opportunity for CQRs participating in the Pan Cancer Initiative.

This opportunity will fund a set of projects to enable automated data capture across the Pan Cancer CQR Network to reduce data collection burden and improve data quality and sustainability.

We anticipate that successful applications will focus on three key pillars:

1. Collaboration - designed for scale across the network, rather than optimisation for a single CQR.
2. Sustainability – built into project design from the outset, rather than considered later.
3. Improved efficiency - demonstrating clear, measurable gains in efficiency.

Applications are due on 7 April at 23.59, with the 6–12-month projects expected to commence on 1 June 2026.



WORK PACKAGE 4 – PUBLIC ACCESS TO PROSTATE CANCER PRO DATA - UPDATE

Work Package 4 has made significant progress over recent months. Two Working Group workshops and three Lived Experience workshops held in late 2025, focusing on priority areas for a tool that will provide public access to benchmarked prostate cancer patient-reported outcome data.

The team have now entered the requirements-gathering phase, identifying key features and priorities for the tool ahead of the build phase.
